## $\Pi$ . Application Instructions

## **■.1. Program Duration**

Undergraduate programs must be completed within 4-6 years. Master's program must be completed within 1-4 years and PH.D programs within 2-7 years. If holding the certificate(diploma) of SPM, must earn more credit following NTPU School Regulation(For detailed regulations, please refer to our university website: "Homepage / Offices / Office of Academic Affairs / Regulations & Policies / National Taipei University Academic Regulations" <a href="https://reurl.cc/vveOYL">https://reurl.cc/vveOYL</a>).

## **□** .2. How and When to Apply

- Step 1 Online Application from September 3 to October 31, 2025 (Taiwan Time). Upload required documents, and click "confirm" after checking your data.
- Step 2 The above process must be completed before October 31, 2025 (Taiwan Time), or your application will be unsuccessful. Late or incomplete submission, application documents submitted in person or by post mail are not be processed.

## **■ .3.** Eligibility

#### A. Definition of International Students

- Those who have foreign nationality and have never held R.O.C. nationality and also who do not possess overseas Chinese student status at the time of their applications.
- ⊙Those who have foreign nationality and have resided overseas (excluding Mainland China, Hong Kong, and Macau) for more than 6 consecutive years (whose stay in Taiwan per calendar year does not exceed a total of 120 days before February 1, 2026), must fulfill the following requirements:
  - 1. In possession of R.O.C. nationality at the time of application, but have never held household registration in Taiwan since birth.
  - 2. In possession of R.O.C. nationality prior application, but ceased to possess the nationality for at least 8 years since the date on which a revocation was issued the Ministry of the Interior, up to February 1, 2026.
  - 3. In either of the cases as described in the preceding two paragraphs, those who have never studied in Taiwan under the status of an overseas Chinese student and those who have been never accepted for 2025 admission placement by University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese students.
- ©Those who once had R.O.C. nationality and applied to renounce R.O.C. nationality (prior to February 1, 2018) for at least 8 years since the date, on which a revocation was issued from the Ministry of the Interior, up to February 1, 2026.
- ⊙Those who have foreign nationality, concurrently holding a permanent residence status in Hong Kong or Macau, but never held household registration in Taiwan since birth at the time of application, have resided in Hong Kong, Macau, or overseas (excluding Mainland China) for more than 6 consecutive years prior to February 1,

- 2026, and who stay in Taiwan per calendar year do not exceed a total of 120 days.
- ⊙Those who were the former citizens of Mainland China and currently have foreign nationality, but have never held household registration in Taiwan since birth at the time of application, have resided overseas (excluding Mainland China, Hong Kong, and Macau) for more than 6 consecutive years prior to February 1, 2026, and who stay in Taiwan per calendar year do not exceed a total of 120 days.
- ⊙Those who have been selected by a foreign government, organization, schools or educational/ cultural group according to the Education Cooperation Framework Agreement and do not hold the household registration since birth as well as receive the approval from the designated authorized government educational institutions.
- \*According to Article 2 of the Nationality Act, a person shall have the nationality of Republic of China under any conditions provided by the following subparagraphs:
  - 1. His/ Her father or mother was a national of R.O.C. when he/she was born.
  - 2. He/ She was born after the death of his/her father or mother, and his/her father or mother was a national of R.O.C. at the time of death.
  - 3. He/ She was born in the territory of the R.O.C., and his/her parents can't be ascertained or both were stateless persons.
  - 4. He/ She has undergone the nationalization process.

## B. Educational/Academic Background

- ⊚International students with a high school diploma or above are eligible to apply for undergraduate programs, bachelor's degree or above for Master programs, and Master's degree or above for Ph.D. programs.
- Applicants with equivalent qualifications to the academic degree system of R.O.C. can
   apply for admission.

## C. Chinese Proficiency Ability

©Language requirements may differ from program to program. If required otherwise, the applicants should meet the specific requirements demanded by the intended departments or graduate programs.

## **II.5.** Release of Application Results

- ⊚The list of students admitted to NTPU will be posted on the NTPU English website (http://www.ntpu.edu.tw/english/) on December 9, 2025. Acceptance letters will be sent to the mailing address provided by applicants.
- Admission letter will post via mailing address (provided by applicant online applied). Applicants should confirm the mailing address is valid before February 23, 2026. Post admission letter again or change mailing address will not be permitted.

Admitted students must return the **reply slip** (in admission letter) by email, fax before **December 31, 2025**. If your confirmation is not completed by the deadline, your admission will be canceled.

Waiting list students must return the **reply slip** (in waiting list letter) by email, fax before **December 31, 2025**. If your confirmation is not completed by the deadline, your waiting list will be canceled.

#### II.6. Verification and Check-in for Admitted Students

OAdmitted students must complete check in at the Admission and General Affairs Section, Office of Academic Affairs, within the timeframe specified in the admission letter. Failure to complete the check-in process by the deadline without prior notice to the university will result in forfeiture of admission.

#### **O** Required Documents for Check-in:

#### 1.Admission Letter

The official admission letter issued by the university.

#### 2. Passport and Visa

A valid visa is required for residing in Taiwan. Even if you are from a visa-free country, you must apply for a Resident Visa before your arrival. This visa is necessary for obtaining the Alien Resident Certificate (ARC) after entering Taiwan. Failure to apply in advance may require you to leave the country or complete additional procedures to obtain the ARC. #### 5. Proof of Financial Resources

Proof of sufficient financial resources to cover your studies and living expenses in Taiwan.

X Upon receiving the admission letter, students must submit a diploma (degree certificate), transcripts, and other relevant academic credentials verified by the appropriate authorities, in accordance with the specified regulations. Students must complete the check-in process to finalize enrollment and begin their studies.

## .7. Registration

#### **©Reserve Admission Status**

Admitted students who, due to pregnancy, childbirth, raising children under three years old, serious illness, other serious incidents or accidents, are not able to register at the beginning of the semester, can apply to reserve his/ her admission status for admission. - ©Those who have been approved to make initial Household Registration, Moving-in Registration, or Acquisition or Restoration of Nationality during their study in Taiwan and have thus ceased to possess the status as foreign students, shall be expelled from any school they are attending.
- ⊙Those who withdraw or are expelled from school in the Republic of China due to misbehavior, unacceptable academic performance or conviction of a penal crime may not thereafter apply again for admission under Regulation Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan. Violation of this regulation will result in the rejection of an application for admission.
- ⊚The acceptance letter or admission notice does not guarantee the issue of a visa. A visa can be approved only by the Bureau of Consular Affairs, Ministry of Foreign Affairs or Taiwan Overseas Representative Offices. Some Taiwan Overseas Representative Offices may require the applicants to submit the proof of Chinese or English Language Proficiency for visa application, please contact the Taiwan Overseas Representative Offices in/near your country.

## Notification of the Collection, Processing and Use of Personal Information for Applicants

- 1. Please read carefully the notification of the Collection, Processing and Use of personal Information for Applicants of National Taipei University (hereinafter referred to as the "University") according to the Articles 8 and 9 of the Personal Data Protection Law (hereinafter referred to as the "Act").
- 2. Purpose of collecting personal information:
