- I. Grant category :
- (I) Academic mentor guidance: To subsidize the full-time faculty and research fellows (including contracted teaching staff and contracted research fellows) who are newly recruited with a seniority of 8 years or less and a rank as an associate professor or an associate researcher or lower make a request from mentoring scholars for consulting, paper writing, project application and other matters related to teaching and research.
- (II) Interdisciplinary research and industry-academia cooperative research consulting: To subsidize faculty who would like to do interdisciplinary research or industry-academia cooperative research to make a request from mentoring scholars for consulting.
- II. Applicants who ever received this grant, whose case was closed 3 years ago or more shall attach one of the following execution results from the previous case:
 - i. Proof of showing that research results were submitted to or accepted for publication in the journals stipulated in Article 3 of the Regulations Governing Awards for Academic Research of NTPU.
 - ii. Approved budget lists or contracts of industry-academia-government research projects.
- III. Mentoring scholars shall be professors or researchers and meet one of the following criteria:
 - Ever received important awards from the National Science and Technology Council or the Ministry of Education, the National Chair Scholarship from the Ministry of Education, or the Outstanding Scholarship from the Foundation for the Advancement of Outstanding Scholarship.
 - (II) Published 5 or more academic journal papers or academic books in relevant fields in the past 5 years.
 - (III) Executed 3 or more research projects authorized or subsidized by off-University units in the past 5 years.
- IV. Required Document: One hard copy of the application form, one electronic file of the application form, and one consent letter from the mentoring scholar.
- V. Grant Period: From the approved date to Nov. 30, 2025.
- VI. Applicant's receipt of relevant awards or grants from NTPU in the past three years

will be considered in the review process.

- VII. Applications will undergo an internal review conducted by the Office of Research and Development (ORD).
