2025 NTPU Pathfinding Research Projects in the Field of Sustainable Development

Applications are open now!

Deadline: 5:00 pm Feb. 21 (Friday), 2025

- I. Summary of key points for applications:
- (I) Eligibility: The project must be conducted by one faculty or research fellow of NTPU [including the full-time faculty, full-time research fellows, contracted teaching staff, and contracted research fellows, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Investigator (PI)] and the PI is required to supervise at least one student.
- (II) The prioritization of grant allocation will be determined as follows:
 - i. First priority: The PI with a seniority of less than 8 years (inclusive) and not receiving any grant from off-University projects at the time of applying for this grant (excluding projects with extended deadlines).
 - ii. Second priority: The PI with a seniority of more than 8 years and not receiving any grant from off-University projects at the time of applying for this grant (excluding projects with extended deadlines)
 - iii. Third priority: The PI who meets the eligibility criteria stated in (I) but does not fall within the categories mentioned in the first and second priorities.
- II. Project topics: The project topic must be relevant to one of the following items, with the first item being given priority:
- (I) The United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
- (II) ESG (Environment, Social, and Governance).
- (III) Others related to sustainable development.
- III. Grant period: From the approval date to Nov. 30, 2025.
- IV. The upper limit of grant per application is NT\$100,000, and the subsidized amount will be adjusted according to the number of applications and the total budget for subsidies.
- V. Required Document for application: One hard copy and one electronic file of the application form.
- VI. Applicant's receipt of relevant awards or grants from NTPU in the past three years will be considered in the review process.

- VII. Applications will undergo an internal review conducted by the Office of Research and Development (ORD).
