Application Instructions for the 2025 Fall Diverse Study Group

1. Purpose of the Activity

To encourage dormitory students to engage in diverse learning experiences, enhance opportunities for academic exploration and interaction, and independently construct their learning domains. This initiative aims to enable dormitory students to become active knowledge builders in a dynamic and diverse manner while promoting a broad range of learning topics to spark more intellectual inspiration.

	<p>1. Invoices must include the tax ID number 10617383, while receipts must have the store's business number, store stamp, and the total amount written in uppercase letters.</p> <p>2. Electronic invoices are accepted, but they must not be stored in a digital carrier.</p>

4. Activity Description

Following the scaffolding theory through group reading, students can enhance their learning effectiveness. Each group must consist of at least three members and hold at least four discussion sessions.

Subsidy details: Each group will receive a subsidy of **NTD 3,000**, which can be used for:

- **Book purchases** (maximum subsidy of **NTD 499** per book)
- **Meal expenses** (maximum subsidy of **NTD 100** per person per meal)
- **Printing expenses**

There are no restrictions on book content as long as it serves an educational purpose. However, books involving **obscene content, excessive violence, or age-restricted material** are **not eligible** for subsidies. Additionally, each group **must hold at least four discussion sessions**.

If at least one member of the reading club is an **international dormitory student** at NTPU, the group can receive an **additional NTD 500 subsidy**, increasing the total subsidy to **NTD 3,500**. However, since this funding comes from dormitory resources, it is **only available to students residing in the Sanxia Campus dormitories**.

Group leader requirements:

- The group leader **must** be a resident of the **Sanxia Campus dormitory**.


- The subsidy will be deposited into the group leader's account.
- This must be specified in the proposal, and all group members must acknowledge and sign their agreement.


Application Requirements:

- Submit an **Application Form** and **Proposal** upon application.
- Submit the following for final reporting:
 - **Records of each discussion session**
 - **Reading club reflection record and satisfaction survey**
 - **Invoices/receipts**
 - **Two original photos** showing all group members engaged in a group reading discussion
