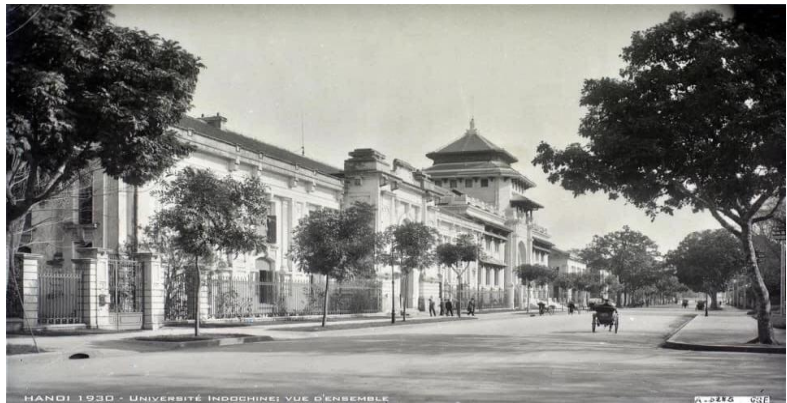
## I. HISTORY OF VNU

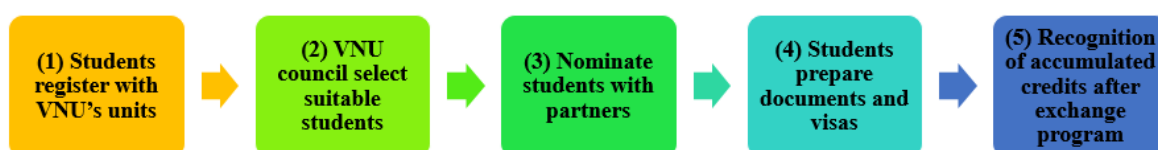

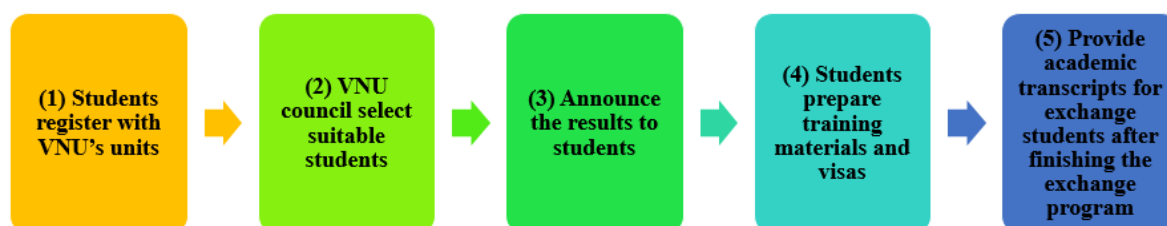

## IV. REQUIREMENTS FOR EXCHANGE STUDENT

### 1. Selection criteria for incoming students

- Achieve a **GPA of 2.8/ 4.0** or higher (accumulated grade).
- **IELTS certificate of 5.5 or equivalent** (in accordance with the language used in the exchange program). Foreign language certificates must be valid for 02 years from the date of examination to the date of application submission to VNU's units and VNU council.

- Have the Health certificate for studying abroad.

### 2. Selection criteria for incoming students

- Students nominated by the partners for the exchange programs at VNU.
- The student has completed at least 2 semesters from the universities which VNU/training units have signed cooperation agreements with or are members of associations and projects that VNU/training units hold membership.



- Achieve a **GPA of 2.8/ 4.0** or higher (accumulated grade).
- **IELTS certificate of 5.5 or equivalent** (in accordance with the language used in the exchange program). Foreign language certificates must be valid for 02 years from the date of examination to the date of application submission to VNU/training units.
- The validity of passports shall be in line with the duration of exchange programs and the current regulations of the government.
- Be physically fit, have a study plan during the exchange period at VNU.
- Commit to following regulations of VNU/ training unit and the law of Vietnam during the exchange period.

#### **a) Me Tri Dormitory**

- Me Tri Dormitory consists of two 5-storey buildings and two 4-storey buildings with 272 rooms, providing accommodation for 1,900 students. There are many kinds of rooms equipped with adequate facilities serving students' life and study
