

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- An official letter issued by your university.
- Complete <u>KMUTT Incoming Exchange Application Form</u> with photograph (size: 1") and <u>KMUTT</u>
 Learning Agreement,
 - Official transcript of academic records.

- A copy of passport.
- English language proficiency test results such as TOFEL iTP of at least 500 or TOEFL iBT of at least 35-45 or IELTS of at least 5.0 or a Recommendation Letter by your English lecture (waive for English native speakers). Interview may be requested on a case by case basic.
 - A medical certificate or a recommendation letter from a doctor or an authorized medical specialist certifying that you are physically and mentally able to take the course and/or are in good health.
 - Additional relevant materials if required by the program you are applying to.


