- 一、依據:台灣賴清德總統於2025年1月24日宣布「青年百億海外 圓夢基金計畫」正式啟動,強調未來亦將開放名額提供邦交國 青年,鼓勵其等透過自主提案或參與我政府計畫來台圓夢,並 於返國後帶動當地社會進步。
- 二、計畫內容:為利增進國際青年交流,深化與我友好國家之鏈結, 有效達成「榮邦」理念,鼓勵我友邦青年發揮創新思維,自行 規劃及向我提交來台圓夢內容具體行動方案計畫書,經外館 審查提報外交部及教育部通過後來台進行圓夢計畫。

## 三、適用對象:

- (一) 我友邦18歲至30歲之品學兼優青年學子(辦理徵件截止日前,須年滿 18 歲且未滿 31 歲)。
- (二) 未曾來台,甚或未曾出國之友邦青年為優先。
- (三) 英語能力佳,具備口語表達能力及應對交流者。
- 四、名額:2025年各邦交國推薦青年以1至2名為度。
- 五、程期:9至12月,至少2週以上,以不超過3個月為原則。
- 六、遴選方式:申請者逕向駐外使館提交提案,由駐館辦理宣傳、審查提案及面試等事宜,嗣將核錄人選及提案內容於\_\_月\_ 日前報部,本部將與教育部共同審查。

## 七、申請資格:

- (一) 由個人提出申請。
- (二)每位青年每年以參加1次、每次申請 1 案為原則(可參考 附件1建議觀摩交流組織清單)。
- 八、**主題**:2025年以「永續觀光」、「智慧農業」、「體育外交」 及「文化外交」4主題領域供青年申請。

# 2025 Taiwan Global Pathfinders Initiative Diplomatic Allies Inbound Track Proposal-based Application Guidelines

Ministry of Foreign Affairs ROC (Taiwan) March 10, 2025

**A. Background:** On January 24, 2025, President Lai Ching-te announced the launch of the Taiwan Global Pathfinders Initiative. He stressed that a number of slots in the program would be reserved for young people from Taiwan's diplomatic allies. This would allow them to realize their dreams in Taiwan, whether by drafting their own proposals or participating in government programs. And upon returning to their home countries, they could contribute to social progress.



**Program overview:** To promote international youth exchanges, deepen ties with friendly nations, and achieve the vision of having prosperous allies, the program encourages young people from Taiwan's diplomatic allies to be innovative, draft proposals, and submit action plans to fulfill their dreams in Taiwan. Participants who pass a review and are approved by Taiwan's embassies may travel to Taiwan under the initiative.



### C. Eligibility:

- a. Outstanding youth (18-30 years old) from Taiwan's diplomatic allies.
- b. Priority will be given to those who have never visited Taiwan or traveled abroad.
- c. Applicants are required to be proficient in English and have good communication skills.
- **D.** Quota: Each diplomatic ally may recommend one to two candidates in 2025.
- **E. Program duration:** A minimum duration of two weeks and a maximum of three months during the September to December period.

## F. Selection process:


Applicants are to submit proposals to Taiwan's embassies in their home countries. The embassies will be responsible for recruitment, proposal review, and interviews. Selected candidates and their proposals will be presented to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Ministry of Education for final approval.

## **G.** Application requirements:

- a. Applications are to be submitted individually.
- b. Each applicant may participate only once per year and submit only one proposal (refer to Attachment 1 for a list of suggested host organizations in Taiwan).
- **H. Themes:** In 2025, applications are to focus on one of the following four themes:
  - a. Sustainable tourism
  - b. Smart agriculture
  - c. Sports diplomacy
  - d. Cultural diplomacy

## **Proposal content:**

- a. Personal introduction (including academic background, work experience, interests, etc.)
- b. Project concept (motivation and objectives)
- c. Personal application or via a host organization or exchange unit
- d. Expected training or exchange activities
- e. Program duration (two weeks to three months)
- f. Planning, progress tracking, and project execution details
- g. Budget



### K. Additional information:

a. Overseas missions are to process visa applications in accordance with regulations.



b. Overseas missions are to include in the program announcement the notice that participants from diplomatic allies who fail to follow the designated program and do not make corrections after having been instructed to do so, or who violate relevant regulations or run afoul of Taiwan law, may have their participation in the program terminated, be required to return home, and be liable to repay any subsidies received.
