VLOG Contest on Haishan Culture

1. Purpose

This contest is to encourage our students to get to know Haishan Culture. It is hoped that, through this contest, the participants will have the chance to choose their own themes, conduct research for gaining better understanding of traditional industries, architectures and relics, cuisines, and natural spots. The teams can make use of their creative ideas to combine with social media for leading the public to learn more about the culture in the Haishan area.

- 2. This activity/contest is held by Language Center (LC) at National Taipei University with the funding support from National Taipei University, Office of Higher Education Sprout Project 1.1-1.
- 3. Qualification for Contest Participation
 - (1) For those who want to take part in the VLOG Contest (Chinese clips), the participants have to be foreign students in Taiwan, including those studying at NTPU for their bachelor's, Master's, and doctoral degrees. Exchange students are included as well. Students from all programs are welcome.
 - (2) Those who want to participate in this contest must be aware of the following details.
 - 1. Each participating team must have a team leader who is responsible for maintaining contact with Language Center at NTPU.
 - 2. Each team is limited to 3 to 4 members (including the team leader), but participants can come from different departments and different academic statuses (years in university).
 - 3. Each student can participate in this contest as a member of ONLY one team. No repeated enrollment on different teams is allowed.
 - 4. Once the application procedures are completed, team members can no longer be altered.
 - 5. Each team can only submit one Vlog which has not been previously released publicly, used in any other contest, awarded in any contest, or authorized for the use of any third party. Any violation will lead to a disqualification of the contest participation.
- 4. How to Participate in the Contest:
 - (1) This contest does not require any fee from participants for registration.
 - (2) Please pay attention to the following time table.

(3) As this contest takes online registration, those teams interested in participating in this contest will send all the required documents (see the above table) to <u>ntpulc418@gmail.com</u> according to the time line. All deadlines are based on the university system (same as LC system). All documents cannot be modified once they are submitted. All documents have to be submitted before 5pm on 2019.11.20. No late or incomplete submission will be processed. Once the registration is completed, the teams will receive a confirmation email. With this confirmation email, the steps are formally completed.

5. Evaluation

- (1) The evaluation process will be divided into two phases. In the first phase, attention will be given to the "completeness" of the submitted documents. In the second phase, attention will be separated into two parts: Internet Popularity Voting (similar to E-voting) and Committee Evaluation (by designated teachers in LC).
- (2) The VLOGs are judged based on the following criteria.

(3) Other details:

- (a) The Vlog should be limited to 3 minutes. Any violation (Vlog length not meeting 2 minutes and 30 seconds or exceeding 3 minutes and 30 seconds) will result in a three-point deduction from the total.
- (b) If two or more teams have the same total, the final decision will be made through the decision of LC faculty.

6. Contest rules:

- (1) Vlog content: The main themes of this Vlog contest are set to be one or combined features from the following list. All Vlogs should be around three minutes long.
 - (a) Features from traditional industries
 - (b) Introduction of legendary figures
 - (c) Exploration of natural ecology

- (d) Cuisines with local features
- (e) Introduction of ancient architectures
- (2) Vlog formats can be Mpeg4, avi, or Mov. The size should be more than the minimum of 1280x960. The length should be between 2.30 minutes to 3.30 minutes. Vlog screen ratio is 16:9 and caption of the chosen language should be provided. The Vlog should be named in the format of "Vlogname – Teamleadername."
- (3) Awards:
 - (a) The first-prize winning team will be awarded with a NT\$5,000 gift certificate and award certificates to all members.
 - (b) The second-prize winning team will be awarded with a NT\$3,000 gift certificate and award certificates to all members.
 - (c) The third-prize winning team will be awarded with a NT\$2,000 gift certificate and award certificates to all members.
 - (d) The list of award winning teams will be announced on 2019.12.11, and all details will be published on LC's official website and LC FB page.
